Fire Safety

Residents and families are encouraged to participate in the fire drills. Drills take place 3 times monthly (one on each shift). Upon hearing the fire alarm, please remain calm, close doors and windows, and wait for direction from the staff.

Codes

peopleCare utilizes a universal emergency code system as a part of the emergency preparedness program. This system provides ease of communication and identification of the appropriate emergency plan.

Code Red: Fire Emergency

Code Green: Evacuation

Code Blue: Medical Emergency

Code Yellow: Missing Resident

Code White: Violent / Aggressive Behaviour

Code Orange: Disaster Contingency Plans

Code Black: Bomb Threat

Code Purple: Intruder

Code Brown: Chemical Spill

Code Grey: External Air Contamination

peopleCare is committed to early identification of risk factors that could result in an incident. We urge residents, families and visitors to immediately report anything they feel is a hazard to a staff member, such as the Charge Nurse. The Home investigates all potential risks to ensure that action is taken to prevent an event or injury.

Infection Prevention and Control

peopleCare works to promote resident and family awareness regarding the risk of infection, as well as prevention of the spread of disease. The Home works closely with Public Health and other government agencies as a part of the commitment to early detection, minimizing the transmission and controlling infections for the well being of residents, staff, volunteers and visitors.
