Message from the Executive Director

Dear Residents, Families and Loved Ones,

November was an incredibly busy month at Hilltop with Accreditation, followed by our Movember fundraising campaign and Residents' Council Christmas Bazaar. It was great to get to see many of you at the Bazaar! Thank you to all the staff, residents and loved ones who helped to make this day a success.

Our accreditation survey went extremely well. Two surveyors spent a week in our homes reviewing 451 quality standards. peopleCare as an organization missed just three, giving us a result of 99.9%. We could not have achieved this result without the support of our Resident and Family Councils, staff, volunteers, leaders and broader community, all of whom were engaged in this process. Please accept my heartfelt thanks. I am proud of Hilltop Manor.

We are looking forward to seeing you at our Resident Christmas Dinner on Wednesday, December 18th at 5pm (RSVP by December 11th). Also a reminder that Santa is coming to breakfast at Hilltop Manor on Saturday, December 21st, 9am is Breakfast and Santa will arrive at 10am. It is imperative that we maintain safe access for emergency vehicles and services we rely on.
